Gentlemen:

Your application for extension of time in which to complete construction work and make complete application of water to beneficial use under the terms of Permit No. U-747 has been considered.

Information set out in the application appears to refer primarily to work done on another permit and does not indicate there has been any progress on the use of water from this specific well since 1959. I am permitted by law to extend the time for completion of construction work and application of water to beneficial use upon showing of reasonable diligence in the development of the project. Work done on other wells and other projects may be fully justified from the land owners standpoint, but I cannot consider it as diligence under the one specific permit in question. It would appear that your best procedure in this case would be to authorize the cancelation of the permit and refile a new application when you are in the position to apply this water to beneficial use.

I have also considered your application for extension of time under Permit No. U-745 which covers the appropriation of water from wells Nos. 1, 2 and 3 for irrigation and supplemental irrigation of 519.2 acres.

From the information stated, it does not appear that there has been any progress during the duration of the last extension which covered the period October 1, 1961 to October 1, 1963. Under these circumstances, it is doubtful if I could further extend the time for this development. Since part of the work has been completed and water put to beneficial use, your best procedure would be to make proof to that extent and then refile a new application when you are in a position to complete the development.
