

Final Order
Extension of Time for Permit Number G-13052

Appeal Rights

This is a final order other than contested case. Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-080 and OAR 690-01-005 you may either petition the Director for reconsideration of this order or petition for judicial review of this order. As provided in ORS 536.075, this order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review of the order must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2).

Application History

On March 15, 2004, John M. Seidler submitted an application to the Department for an extension of time for permit number G-13052. The Department issued permit number G-13052 on December 18, 1996. The permit called for completion of construction of the water development project by October 1, 1998, and complete application of water to beneficial use by October 1, 1999. In accordance with OAR 690-315-0050(2), on July 13, 2004, the Department issued a Proposed Final Order proposing to extend the time to complete construction of the water development project and the time to fully apply water to beneficial use to October 1, 2004. The protest period closed August 27, 2004, in accordance with OAR 690-315-0060(1). No protest was filed.

The applicant has demonstrated good cause for the permit extension pursuant to ORS 537.230, 537.248, 537.630, 539.010(5) and/or OAR 690-315-0040(2).

Order

The extension of time for Application Number G-13163, Permit Number G-13052, therefore, is approved. The deadline for completing construction is extended to October 1, 2004. The deadline for applying water to full beneficial use is extended to October 1, 2004.
