A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Application History

Permit S-52617 was issued by the Department on August 14, 1996. The permit called for actual construction to begin by August 14, 1997, completion of construction by October 1, 1998, and complete application of water to beneficial use by October 1, 1999. On June 15, 2016, Linda K. Mallery-McLean submitted an Application for Extension of Time for Permit S-52617. In accordance with OAR 690-315-0050(2), on July 26, 2016, the Department issued a Proposed Final Order proposing to extend the time to complete construction from October 1, 1998 to October 1, 2001, and the time to apply water to full beneficial use from October 1, 1999 to October 1, 2001. The protest period closed September 9, 2016, in accordance with OAR 690-315-0060(1). No protest was filed.

FINDINGS OF FACT

The Department adopts and incorporates by reference the findings in the Proposed Final Order dated July 26, 2016.

At time of issuance of the Proposed Final Order the Department concluded that, based on the factors demonstrated by the applicant, the permit may be extended subject to no additional conditions.

CONCLUSION OF LAW

The applicant has demonstrated good cause for the permit extension pursuant to ORS 537.230, 539.010(5) and OAR 690-315-0040(2).

The extension of time for Application S-72092, Permit S-52617, therefore, is approved. The deadline for completing construction is extended from October 1, 1998 to October 1, 2001. The deadline for applying water to full beneficial use within the terms and conditions of the permit is extended from October 1, 1999 to October 1, 2001.
