**PUBLIC INTEREST PRESUMPTION; GROUNDWATER**

**OAR 690-310-130 (1)** *The Department shall presume that a proposed groundwater use will ensure the preservation of the public welfare, safety and health as described in ORS 537.525. **B. GROUNDWATER AVAILABILITY CONSIDERATIONS, OAR 690-310-130, 400-010, 410-0070**

B3. **Groundwater availability remarks:** There are no Observation Well data in the immediate area of the applicant’s proposed POA (nearest, JOSE 19746, is nearly 2 mile west and in different geologic formation) so groundwater over-appropriation cannot be empirically determined. However, the POA is within the larger Grays Creek Pluton geologic formation which, along with other plutonic aquifers in the region, does not appear to be currently over-appropriated. There are no other permitted groundwater rights in Section 28 so injury to existing rights is unlikely.

**Basis for aquifer confinement evaluation:** The applicant's well log for the proposed POA reports SWL considerably above first water, indicating confined aquifer conditions.

**Basis for aquifer hydraulic connection evaluation:** GW elevations are estimated to be above SW elevations suggesting groundwater is flowing towards and discharging to surface water.

\*The USGS Topo Maps show the main river channel to be considerably east of the aerial imagery. The distance in Table C2 is based on the aerial imagery.

**NOTE:** Johnston Cr is a nearby mapped creek but was not evaluated for hydraulic connection because it was determined not to be a significant surface water source based on aerial imagery and that there are no surface water PODs on the creek except a single surface right at the headwaters for 0.02 cfs.

**Comments:** \*\*Interference @ 30 d could not be estimated because the terrain (high-relief slopes) and geology (fractured bedrock aquifer) do not meet model assumptions of the widely accepted techniques for determining stream depletion (e.g., Hunt 1999, 2003).

However, the reviewer is unable to find a preponderance of evidence that the proposed use will have the Potential for Substantial Interference (PSI) with surface water.
