CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That RALPH LEHMANN of Route 1, Box 266, Newberg, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to store the waters of an unnamed stream, tributary of Chehalis River, to be appropriated under Application No. 26746, Permit No. 20926,

for the purposes of irrigation

under Reservoir Permit No. R-1292 of the State Engineer, and that said right to store said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 27, 1951

that the amount of water entitled to be stored each year under such right, for the purposes aforesaid, shall not exceed 9.4 acre-feet.

The reservoir is located in Section 12 (SW 1/4 NE 1/4) (NW 1/4 SE 1/4), Tp. 3 S., R. 3 W., W.M. both as projected within Jones DLG #44.

Dear Mr. Lehmann:

We are enclosing herewith for completion, final proof in connection with the incomplete water right represented by your Permit No. 20926 granting a right to the use of 0.17 cfs of the waters of unnamed branch and reservoir, for irrigation, and Permit No. R-1292 for 9.4 a.f. from unnamed stream for storage of water and irrigation.

The data contained in the proof, which is based on an inspection and survey of your project made by a representative of this department, defines the extent to which your water right has been completed within the terms of your Permit. The proof should be dated and signed by you on the second sheet under the Affidavit of Appropriator and returned to this office.

Upon receipt of the proof, properly executed and accompanied by the statutory fee of \$1, a Certificate of Water Right will be issued confirming the rights thereunder and, after being recorded in the records of Yamhill County, will be forwarded to you.

In the interest of economy and due to the fact that your completed project was examined by a representative of this department, it is not necessary that your signature be made before a Notary Public, nor that the signatures of witnesses be affixed to the proof.

Our receipt No. 13780, in the amount of \$30, is enclosed herewith to cover the fees which you submitted.

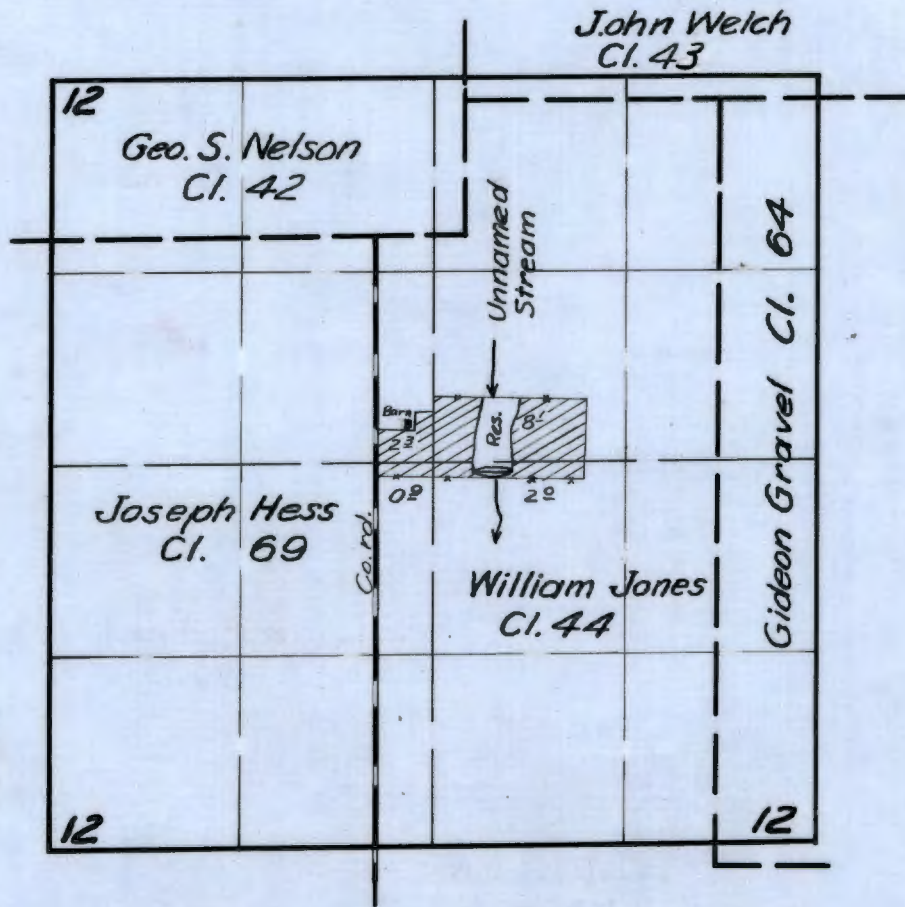
