This will acknowledge receipt of your notice to the effect that complete application of water has been made under Permit No. 23540.

Pursuant to your report and in line with the general practice of this office, a survey will be made at a later date. In case of irrigation, any lands described in the permit that have not been irrigated will be automatically eliminated from the water right.

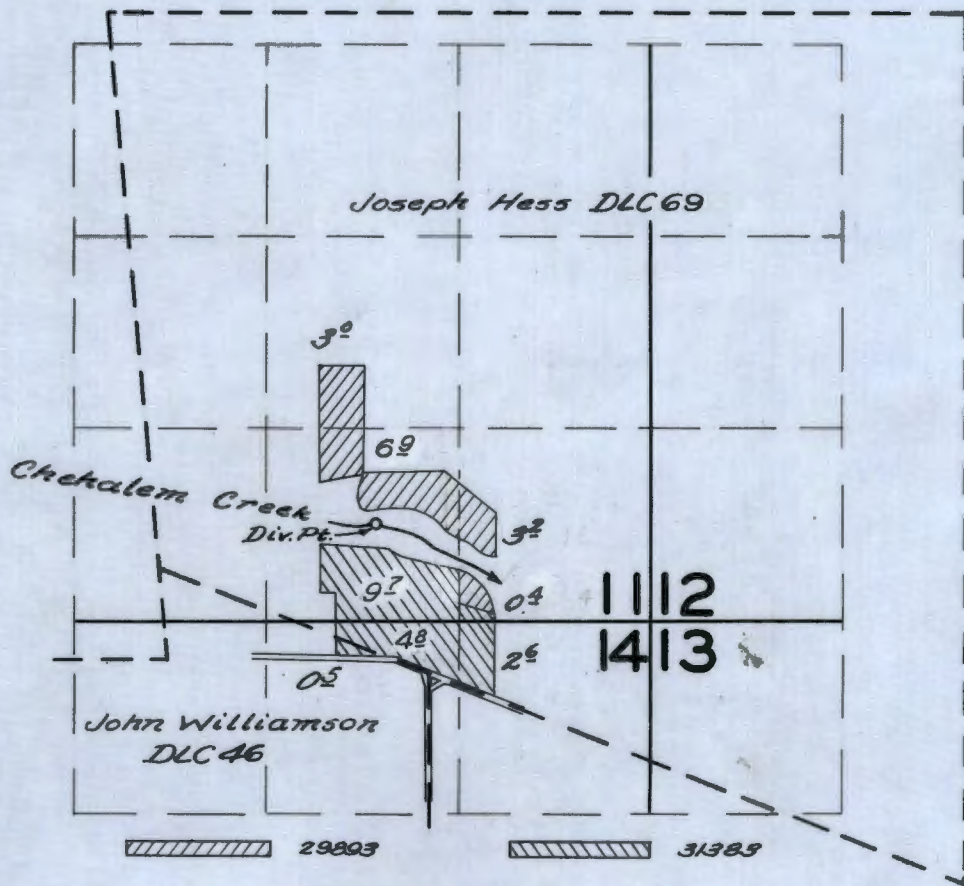
