We are enclosing herewith for completion, final proof in connection with the incomplete water right represented by your Permit No. 2121. granting a right to the use of 0.19 cfs of the waters of unnamed stream and reservoir, for irrigation, and Permit No. R-1375 for 3.5 a.f. from unnamed branch for storage of water and irrigation.

The data contained in the proof, which is based on an inspection and survey of your project made by a representative of this department, defines the extent to which your water right has been completed within the terms of your Permit.
