Water-Use Permit Application Processing

1. Completeness Determination

The Department evaluates whether the application and accompanying map contain all of the information required under OAR 690-310-0040 and OAR 690-310-0050 (www.oregon.gov/owrd/law). The Department also determines whether the proposed use is prohibited by statute. If the Department determines that the application is incomplete, all fees have not been paid, or the use is prohibited by statute, the application and all fees submitted are returned to the applicant.

2. Initial Review

The Department reviews the application to determine whether water is available during the period requested, whether the proposed use is restricted or limited by rule or statute, and whether other issues may preclude approval of or restrict the proposed use. An Initial Review (IR) containing preliminary determinations is mailed to the applicant. The applicant has 14 days from the mailing date to withdraw the application from further processing and receive a refund of all fees paid minus \$200. The applicant may put the application on hold for up to 180 days and may request additional time if necessary.

3. Public Notice

Within 7 days of the mailing of the initial review, the Department gives public notice of the application in the weekly notice published by the Department at www.oregon.gov/owrd. The public comment period is 30 days from publication in the weekly notice.

4. Proposed Final Order Issued

The Department reviews any comments received, including comments from other state agencies related to the protection of sensitive, threatened or endangered fish species. Within 60 days of completion of the IR, the Department issues a Proposed Final Order (PFO) explaining the proposed decision to deny or approve the application. A PFO proposing approval of an application will include a draft permit, and may request additional information or outstanding fees required prior to permit issuance.

5. Public Notice

Within 7 days of issuing the PFO, the Department gives public notice in the weekly notice. Notice includes information about the application and the PFO. Protest must be received by the Department within 45 days after publication of the PFO in the weekly notice. Anyone may file a protest. The protest filing fee is \$350.00 for the applicant and \$700.00 for non-applicants. Protests are filed on approximately 10% of Proposed Final Orders. If a protest is filed, the Department will attempt to settle the protest but will schedule a contested case hearing if necessary.

6. Final Order Issued

If no protests are filed, the Department issues a Final Order consistent with the PFO. If the application is approved, a permit is issued that specifies the details of the authorized use and any terms, limitations or conditions that the Department deems appropriate.

MODIFIED WARRANTY DEED CONVEYING PROPERTY TO REVOCABLE TRUST

BLAKE D. SPOTTEN, Grantor, hereby conveys and warrants to BLAKE DELON SPOTTEN, as trustee of BLAKE D. SPOTTEN REVOCABLE LIVING TRUST u/t/a dated September 25, 2015, Grantee, free of encumbrances except for matters of public record, the real property described as:

Part of the Southwest one-quarter of the Northwest one-quarter and part of Government Lot 3 of Section 5 and part of Government Lot 2 of Section 6, Township 5 South, Range 2 East of the Willamette Meridian, in the County of Clackamas and State of Oregon, described as:

Beginning at a Stake 343.12 feet South of the Southwest corner of the Northeast one-quarter of the Northeast one-quarter of Section 6, Township 5 South, Range 2 East of the Willamette Meridian and running thence South 996.90 feet to a stake on the North boundary of the Wingfield Donation Land Claim; thence South 82° 00' East 1386 feet to the center of the County Road; thence North 19° 00' East 913.40 feet along said road to a stake; thence North 78° 30' West 1707.73 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning.
