CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify. That FRANK SCHIEDLER

of Route 1, Mt. Angel State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Abiqua Creek a tributary of Pudding River irrigation under Permit No. 16364 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters

confirmed dates from June 7, 1945 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes

has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby

aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.60 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW 1 NW 2, Section 24, Township 6 South, Range 1 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

6.0 acres in the SW 3 SW 4, as projected on Randolph C. Gibson D.L.C. No. 54 Section 14

1.2 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on Samuel Tucker D.L.C. No. 52

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by the appropriator as follows: Commencing at the corner of Section 14, 15, 22 and 23, in Township Six (6) South, of Range One West of the Willamette Meridian; thence East on Section line 11.52 chains; thence North 40 degrees and 45' West 18.40 chains along line of County Road; thence North 50 degrees West 14.35 chains along said road thence north 67 degrees West 14.71 chains along road as aforesaid and to a point in the East boundary of a 50 acre tract of land conveyed by Stephen Porter and wife to James Down on the 19th day of May 1869, deed of same being recorded in Marion County Records Book of Deeds, Vol. 20, page 355; thence North 68 degrees and 40 west along aforesaid County Road 13.42 chains to a point in the west boundary of said 50 acre tract of land; thence South 33.86 chains to the South West corner of said 50 acre tract of land; thence East 37.52 chains to the place of beginning, containing 1034 acres of land and situated in Marion County and the State of Oregon, except a tract of land being part of the West side of this tract deeded to M . The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.


