that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.72 cubic feet per second,


Fall Chinook and Coho (federally threatened) salmon, winter steelhead, Pacific lamprey (sensitive), and coastal cutthroat trout use the West Fork of the Illinois River. ODFW believes if this permit is conditioned to reflect the storage period recommended and conditions below, negative impacts to fisheries resources can be lessened.
