Enclosed is the assignment of Permit number 33987 from Bill Rees to you. This has been recorded in the Records of the State Engineer, and our records have been changed accordingly.

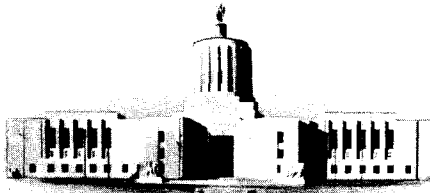

Dear Sir:

This will acknowledge receipt of your application for permit to appropriate 0.76 cubic foot of water per second from two unnamed streams and nine springs for the irrigation of 56 acres, stockwater, and one house domestic use, a map, nine spring description sheets, and the fee of \$33.90 for which our receipt No. 12283 is enclosed. Your application has been filed and numbered 45554.

The application map shows a barn located near the house in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 32. The map does not show a pipe line to the barn from any of the springs. Will there be stockwatering use at the barn, and if so, from what source? Would you also give us the dimensions of your proposed holding pond?

I will withhold further action on your application pending your reply to this matter.
