On August 3, 1979 we received your application for a permit to appropriate 0.0125 cubic foot per second of water from Rainy Creek, with any deficiency in supply to be made up from West Fork Millicoma River, for domestic use for one family, including irrigation of up to  $\frac{1}{2}$  acre non-commercial lawn and garden. Also received were your map, legal description and fees of \$35.00, for which our receipt No. 13240 is enclosed.

On August 27, 1979 we received your application for a permit to appropriate 0.005 cubic foot per second of water from Chute Creek for domestic use for one family and 0.063 cubic foot per second of water from West Fork Millicoma. River for irrigation of 4.0 acres. Also received were your map, legal description and fees of \$10.00, for which our receipt No. 13659 is enclosed. Also received was your request that this application supercede the first application.

Permits will be issued for use of water from Millicoma River and its tributaries. However, water may not be available during dry periods. The water may be needed to satisfy existing rights or minimum flow standards.
