Subj: G11103 - USFS, Diamond Lake Campground

You asked me today for a status report on the above file. I do not believe the December 8, 1994 letter makes any changes regarding amount and type of water use proposed.

I note I had initially used tables from Robison for water availability. Today, as a doublecheck, I ran the Cooper tables, which show the same lack of water because of scenic waterway flow requirements.

There are three questions to be answered:

- 1. Does campground/picnic constitute 'domestic' use as stated in the statute, or
- 2. Does campground/picnic constitute 'recreational' use as stated in the rules?
- 3. Regardless of which option above prevails, the amount requested (50 + 70 gal. = 0.27 cfs total) may not be allowed because of the 0.005 cap on 'human consumption' above or within a scenic waterway.

The file contains the applicant's objections to the unsat. TR, one of which addresses the high public interest. The file should move on to the approving/denying phase of the water right process.
