## Appeal Rights

This final order is subject to judicial review by the Court of Appeals under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482(1). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

## **Application History**

Permit R-14164 was issued by the Department on The permit specified the reservoir was to be filled, and complete application of water was to be made on or before October 1, 2009. On June 29, 2017, Barbra Steele, on behalf of Steele Revocable Trust, submitted an Application for Extension of Time for Permit R-14164. In accordance with OAR 690-315-0050(2), on

August 15, 2017, the Department issued a Proposed Final Order proposing to extend the time to apply water to full beneficial use from October 1, 2009, to October 1, 2026. The protest period closed September 29, 2017, in accordance with OAR 690-315-0060(1). No protest was filed.

## FINDINGS OF FACT

The Department adopts and incorporates by reference the findings in the Proposed Final Order dated August 15, 2017.

At time of issuance of the Proposed Final Order the Department concluded that, based on the factors demonstrated by the applicant, the permit may be extended subject to the following conditions:

#### LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS

## 1. <u>Checkpoint Condition</u>

The permit holder must submit a completed Progress Report Form to the Department by October 1, 2023. A form will be enclosed with your Final Order.

- (a) At each checkpoint, the permit holder shall submit and the Department shall review evidence of the permit holder's diligence towards completion of the project and compliance with terms and conditions of the permit and extension. If, after this review, the Department determines the permit holder has not been diligent in developing and perfecting the water use permit, or complied with all terms and conditions, the Department shall modify or further condition the permit or extension to ensure future compliance, or begin cancellation proceedings on the undeveloped portion of the permit pursuant to ORS 537.260 or 537.410, or require submission of a final proof survey pursuant to ORS 537.250;
- (b) The Department shall provide notice of receipt of progress reports in its weekly notice and shall allow a 30 day comment period for each report. The Department shall provide notice of its determination to anyone who submitted comments.

## 2. <u>Meter Condition</u>

The use of water under Permit R-14164 is conditioned to require the installation of a meter or other suitable measuring device. If a meter or other suitable measuring device is not installed by October 1, 2026, this will be the last extension granted for Permit R-14164 and future extension requests shall be denied.

## **CONCLUSION OF LAW**

The applicant has demonstrated good cause for the permit extension pursuant to ORS 537.230, 539.010(5) and OAR 690-315-0040(2).

## **ORDER**

The extension of time for Application R-86154, Permit R-14164, therefore, is approved subject to conditions contained herein. The deadline for applying water to full beneficial use within the terms and conditions of the permit is extended from October 1, 2009, to October 1, 2026.
