This is to Certify, That The J. F. LUSE COMPANY

of Sutherlin, State of Oregon 97479, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Bank's Creek, and Smith Canyon Creek, tributary of Calapooia River

for the purpose of the irrigation of 243.75 acres and domestic use from Bank's Creek, and the irrigation of 392.75 acres and domestic use from Smith Canyon Creek, under Permit No. 583 and under Enlargement Permit No. 589 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon and duly confirmed by order of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, made and entered

of record in the Record of Proceedings of said Board, at Salem, in Volume 1

at page 191, on the 1st day of September, 1915; that the priority of Creek water and from January 12, 1911 for Smith Canyon Creek water; the right hereby confirmed dates from March 30, 1911 for Bank's; that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not

Rights to the use of water for power purposes are limited to a period of forty years from the date of priority of the right, as herein set forth, subject to a preference right of renewal under the laws existing at the date of the expiration of the right for power purposes, as hereby confirmed and limited.

Gentlemen:

Replying to the directions of the Board at its last meeting, I have investigated the irrigation project of The J. F. Luse Company, successors of The Sutherlin Land & Water Company, at Sutherlin, Oregon in so far as said project is affected by Applications 587, 1192 and 1315.

I found that the applicant in this case had constructed a concrete dam in the Calapooia river and had completed a ditch of apparent sufficient capacity to irrigate the lands under the same. The headgates at the head of this ditch are very substantial in character and the ditch is carefully constructed, being in places cement lined, and undoubtedly constitutes a permanent improvement. Several extensions of this ditch have been made to cover additional land.

In addition to this ditch and its extensions, the applicant has diverted the waters of Sutherlin creek and several small tributaries of Calapooia river mentioned in the applications herewith returned. In my opinion, these ditches constitute permanent improvements, and have been constructed of sufficient

capacity to irrigate the lands described in the applications and for which permits were issued.

I note that several changes have been made in the legal subdivisions irrigated, but the aggregate of lands irrigated in each case does not exceed that originally applied for. The changes in each case cannot injure any other water users, as I understand these appropriations constitute all the appropriations from the various streams appropriated, and there are consequently no intervening rights.

I followed the lines of the various ditches and personally inspected and observed every part of the project, including the lands and ditches described in the applications above referred to. The greater part of the land is in orchard, and bears the appearance of having been irrigated. A portion of the lands, however, are not in orchard but appear to have only natural grasses growing thereon, or to have been planted to some kind of grain crop. These lands, however, I am informed, have been irrigated, although it was impossible to determine that fact from the present appearance of these lands. The ditches constructed, however, are sufficient to irrigate all of the lands for which a right is claimed, in my opinion.

According to the contract between the company and the purchasers of lands under the several ditches, not exceeding six



acre inches are allowed as a perpetual water right running with the land. It would appear to me that the water supply is sufficient, at least in usual years, to afford this quantity of water delivered on the land. The losses in seepage in transit cannot be great in these ditches which are comparatively short, and it appears that there are no other appropriations from these sources. I therefore recommend that water right certificates be issued to the applicant in accordance with the proofs submitted by it.

Dear Mr. Holm:

In reply to your letter of November 23, I am sorry that a satisfactory explanation did not accompany the proposed affidavit of abandonment regarding that portion of the old Sutherlin Land and Water Company's right appurtenant to your property.

The water laws of the State of Oregon provide that if a completed and perfected water right, as evidenced by a certificate, is not exercised for five or more continuous years, the right is subject to cancelation through statutory procedure.

One method of canceling the right is by an affidavit of abandonment by the owner of the property involved. Each time the opportunity presents itself, where we are fairly certain that a right has been abandoned, we ask the property owner to sign and submit an affidavit of abandonment.

The other course of action under the statutes is for the State Engineer to institute a proceeding on his own motion, wherein it is required that he serve registered notice to each property owner involved and give him an opportunity to appear at a public hearing and show cause why the proposed cancelation should not be effected. In following this course of action, it is necessary that a field investigation be made to determine the ownership of each parcel of land covered by the right in question. As soon as we can conveniently do so, it is our intention to conduct this investigation in the matter of the old Sutherlin Land and Water Company's right.

In the meantime if any individual attempts to re-establish a right that you know has not been exercised for at least five or more continuous years, it probably would be to your advantage to make the fact known to this office in the form of a letter. Should you decide to complete and submit the affidavit of abandonment, it will be placed in the Sutherlin Land and Water Company's file until such time as the State Engineer instigates action toward cancelation of the abandoned right.

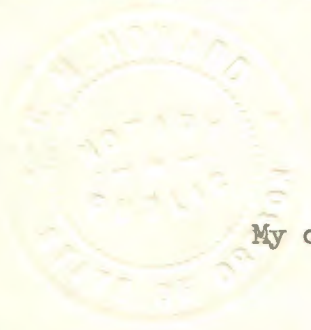

Dear Mr. Conroy:

After our discussion last week (6th) over the abandonment of the old Sutherland Tank & Water right it appears to me that there are some other items that might be of interest to the Engineer's office relative to the use being made of water in this valley.

In a letter dated Aug 7, 1954 written by a Mr. Greer Jones from your office, indication is made of the existence of three (3) industrial rights from the Sutherland Creek & Corners divide (lying over the same). These rights are by no means up to date if the conditions still exist as described in Mr. Jones' letter.

Permit # 15,178 issued & assigned to Rock Island P.L.C. Rock Island P.L.C. (R.I.C.) sold out back in 1945 or 1949 to a plywood corp that now uses the pond & creek right. Later Douglas Sutherland Mill was built near the site of Springfield Plywood Corp mill & began operations out of the same pond in 1953. Now operations are carried on by F & M P.L.C. since 1958.

Permits # 16,109 + R-805 to North Douglas Mill & Pine North Douglas Mill & Pine sold out in 1952 to Sutherland

Enclosed are the maps showing the rights described in Certificates 972 and 973. All we have in the way of final proof maps are blueprints submitted along with the proof, so Floyd traced the pertinent information for you.

Elijah and Sarah Helm filed an affidavit requesting cancellation of that part of Certificate 973 appurtenant to Lots 12 and 13, Block 6, Plat I, and Ivan Helm requested cancellation of that part of the same certificate appurtenant to Lots 5, 6, 7, 8, 10 and the East half of Lot 11, Block 6, Plat I. So you needn't be concerned with these tracts. It is possible that the principal diversion ditch has been in for such a long time, that it is now considered a channel of the creek and some appropriation of water made from this.

After considering our phone conversation a little more, I wonder if some misunderstanding developed along the line from Mr. Wheeler requesting a note as to what brought up an attempt to cancel a water right. The only ones I have been recently concerned with are those which George is acting on when the information comes in, or those that have an error in the original certificate, or those that have been partially cancelled. In none of these cases would we want to issue a certificate describing an abandoned right.

I think Chris had some thought a short time ago for economic reasons, that he did not care to search for rights which may be abandoned and initiate action for cancellation, unless the need for this was brought to our attention in a different manner. Dear Mr. Youngquist:

The many affidavits submitted by you which were obtained from the Water Control District involving the cancelation of parts of Certificate 973, Permits 553 and E-39, have been platted on the County Assessor's maps which we received. There are a very few of these affidavits which involve lands as evidenced by Certificate 973, being those in the names of Leeper, Strong, Landrum and those previously submitted by Ivan E. Holm and Elijah and Sarah Holm. The others do not appear to be any lands under this certificate. All of the pertinent lands have been noted on the maps in blue color.

We are enclosing prints made from the assessor's maps of Sections 13, 14, 15, 23 and 24, Township 25 South, Range 5 West, W.M., with the acres by quarter section noted in red ink; the boundary and location of the lands evidenced by Certificate 973 are also shown by red cross-hatching, this information and location obtained from the application maps as submitted with No. 1192 and 1315 in the name of Sutherlin Land and Water Company.

The assessor's maps do not clearly define the 1/16 or 1/4 section lines and such have been drawn thereon, but may not be exact. It does not appear that lot lines conform to the quarter lines.

Also on these prints we have noted the following areas, colored in green, which are lands to be irrigated by Sutherlin Water Control District by their application No. 33577, permit No. 31273 and are also under Certificate 973, but no affidavits have been received from these land owners:

Part of Lot 4, Block 6, in Southeasterly part of Section 14,

Part of Lots 14 and 15, Block 6, within Sections 14 and 23.
Affidavits covering these lands will be required if they are to be accepted within the new application No. 33577.

It is very possible that other lands hatched in red, as evidenced by certificate 973, are not being irrigated under this water right, and may be subject to cancelation.

You should make a field inspection at your earliest convenience and ascertain what other lands are subject to cancelation through non use. It is possible that the water control district would assist you in this matter.

If any of the platted roads as shown on the assessor's map are not vacated and are included in the area of the lands under this certificate, it will be necessary to have the county, if they are the owners submit an affidavit to cancel such lands. We presume that any vacated road right of way reverted to the adjacent property owners.
