To irrigate lawn and garden from March through October, consumption to be less than 1.25 af, water to be measured in gallon using a meter on the pump outlet, appropriate fish screens will be used on the inlet, timer will be used to start and stop pump, pumping for short durations one to two times a day, with use based on precipitation.

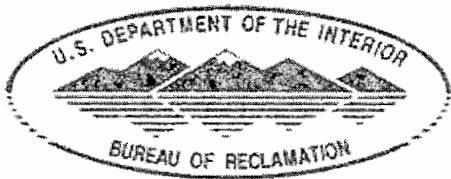
