Gentlemen:

I write as city attorney for the city of Adair Village, Oregon. As you are undoubtedly aware, the city of Adair Village has obtained an interim permit from the Department of Health, Education and Welfare to take possession of and continue to operate water and sewer facilities formerly known as the Adair Air Force Base Water and Sewer System located along the Willamette River in Benton County, Oregon. A copy of that interim permit dated May 2, 1978 and signed by Mr. George E. Hoops, director of the Office of Federal Property Assistance, is enclosed herewith. Will you kindly furnish me with necessary application forms and instructions in order that the city of Adair Village may make application to appropriate waters from the Willamette River as operator of the above-described systems. Reference is made to Application No. 48146, made by the city of Albany, Oregon, the previous possessor and operator of these facilities and permit No. 35819, approved May 15, 1972 by Chris L. Wheeler, State Engineer.
