Summary: Order approving Application S-69623, as amended and issuing Permit S-55119.

Authority

The application is being processed in accordance with Oregon Revised Statute (ORS) 537.153 through 537.175, and 390.826, and Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) Chapter 690, Divisions 5, 33, 300, 310, 400, 410, and Willamette Basin Program OAR 690-502. This Final Order is issued pursuant to ORS 537.170(6) to (9) and OAR 690-310-0170 to 0190.

FINDINGS OF FACT

The findings of fact in the Proposed Final Order issued September 10, 1996 are incorporated herein, with the following exceptions:

- 1. On May 24, 1988, Tualatin Valley Irrigation District submitted an application to the Department for a water use permit.
- 2. The Department issued a Proposed Final Order on September 10, 1996.
- 3. The protest period closed October 25, 1996, and no protest was filed.
- 4. On December 7, 2017, the applicant amended the annual acreage proposed for irrigation to no more than 17,000 acres to be irrigated during any one season.
- 5. On February 26, 2018, the applicant clarified the points of diversion, being Spring Hill Pumping Station on Tualatin River, Patton Valley Pumping Station on Scoggins Creek and Scoggins Reservoir and clarified the uses proposed under this application to be agriculture use and irrigation on 34,675.78 acres, with no more than 17,000 acres irrigated during any one season.
- 6. The proposed use would not impair or be detrimental to the public interest.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The conclusions of law in the Proposed Final Order issued September 10, 1996 are incorporated herein, with the above modifications.

When issuing permits, ORS 537.170(6) authorizes the Department to include provisions or restrictions concerning the use, control and management of the water to be appropriated for the project. Permit S-55119 is conditioned accordingly.

ORDER

Application S-69623, as amended, is approved with Permit S-55119.


