Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Application History

Permit S-53337 was issued by the Department on February 25, 1998. The permit specified complete application of water to beneficial use by October 1, 2002. On February 26, 2018, Broadbent Community Church submitted an Application for Extension of Time for Permit S-53337. In accordance with OAR 690-315-0050(2), on April 10, 2018, the Department issued a

Proposed Final Order proposing to extend the time to apply water to full beneficial use from October 1, 2002, to October 1, 2020. The protest period closed May 25, 2018, in accordance with OAR 690-315-0060(1). No protest was filed.

FINDINGS OF FACT

The Department adopts and incorporates by reference the findings in the Proposed Final Order dated April 10, 2018.

At time of issuance of the Proposed Final Order the Department concluded that, based on the factors demonstrated by the applicant, the permit may be extended subject to no additional conditions.

CONCLUSION OF LAW

The applicant has demonstrated good cause for the permit extension pursuant to ORS 537.230, 539.010(5) and OAR 690-315-0040(2).

ORDER

The extension of time for Application S-81717, Permit S-53337, therefore, is approved. The deadline for applying water to full beneficial use within the terms and conditions of the permit is extended from October 1, 2002 or, to October 1, 2020.
