This is a final order other than contested case. Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-080 and OAR 690-01-005 you may either petition the Director for reconsideration of this order or petition for judicial review of this order. As provided in ORS 536.075, this order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review of the order must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2).

Application History

On September 17, 2002, Morse Brother Inc. submitted an application to the Department for an extension of time for permit number G-13216. The Department issued permit number G-13216 on August 28, 1997. The permit called for complete application of water to the full beneficial use by October 1, 2001. In accordance with OAR 690-315-0050(2), on April 20, 2004, the Department issued a Proposed Final Order proposing to extend the time to fully apply water to beneficial use to October 1, 2002. The protest period closed June 4, 2004, in accordance with OAR 690-315-0060(1). No protest was filed.

The applicant has demonstrated good cause for the permit extension pursuant to ORS 537.230, 537.248, 537.630, 539.010(5) and/or OAR 690-315-0040(2).

Order

The extension of time for Application Number G-14350, Permit Number G-13216, therefore, is approved. The deadline for applying water to full beneficial use is extended to October 1, 2002.
