We are applying for a water right for our residence in Lincoln Co. because the U.S. Forest Service recently denied our permit renewal for water transmission from their land. We have been paying them for permission during the past 20 years or so, and this was the first time we were made aware that the U.S.F.S. was enforcing a policy requiring a water right to extract any water from their land.

The spring contributing to our water supply is quite small, and has been the source of household water for this place since before I purchased the property in 1972, ^{or} maybe 70 or 80 years ago, when the land with a house ^{first} became occupied. This water source has been used continuously before 1970, that I am sure of.

Our house burnt down completely in Dec. 2014, while my brother was living there. We had to replace it with a manufactured home. At that time, our contractor modified the terminal end of the system, then buried most of the line on the lower end.

The primary use for this water is to supply our mfd. home, and to water a small garden. The available amount has been very limited, and not always reliable, so water on the garden has to be hand sprinkled to go far enough to supply the need. The garden area is about 3000ft², or 1/4 of the 1/2 acre allowed for non-commercial gardens.

There is not enough volume to even consider watering any kind of a lawn. That would be a waste.

The water is relatively clean and pure because it is gathered at the source from a branch of the stream, where it seeps out from under a large rock. We have never had the water tested for quality or purity, and have never suspected enough animal activity above the headwater to cause concern about contamination.

Water pressure is not very high because our storage tank does not sit close to the source. Estimated height of the tank above the house level may be 50 ft.

Should a Water Resources representative visit to inspect our system to verify its existence, we feel confident that anyone would agree that the water being transmitted is being put to very good use.

1. Completeness Determination

OWRD

The Department evaluates whether the application and accompanying map contain all of the information required under OAR 690-310-0040 and OAR 690-310-0050 (www.oregon.gov/owrd/law.oar). The Department also determines whether the proposed use is prohibited by statute. If the Department determines that the application is incomplete, all fees have not been paid, or the use is prohibited by statute, the application and all fees submitted are returned to the applicant.

2. Initial Review

The Department reviews the application to determine whether water is available during the period requested, whether the proposed use is restricted or limited by rule or statute, and whether other issues may preclude approval of or restrict the proposed use. An Initial Review (IR) containing preliminary determinations is mailed to the applicant. The applicant has 14 days from the mailing date to withdraw the application from further processing and receive a refund of all fees paid minus \$260. The applicant may put the application on hold for up to 180 days and may request additional time if necessary.

3. Public Notice

Within 7 days of the mailing of the initial review, the Department gives public notice of the application in the weekly notice published by the Department at www.oregon.gov/owrd. The public comment period is 30 days from publication in the weekly notice.

4. Proposed Final Order Issued

The Department reviews any comments received, including comments from other state agencies related to the protection of sensitive, threatened or endangered fish species. Within 60 days of completion of the IR, the Department issues a Proposed Final Order (PFO) explaining the proposed decision to deny or approve the application. A PFO proposing approval of an application will include a draft permit, and may request additional information or outstanding fees required prior to permit issuance.

5. Public Notice

Within 7 days of issuing the PFO, the Department gives public notice in the weekly notice. Notice includes information about the application and the PFO. Protest must be received by the Department within 45 days after publication of the PFO in the weekly notice. Anyone may file a protest. The protest filing fee is \$410.00 for the applicant and \$810.00 for non-applicants. Protests are filed on approximately 10% of Proposed Final Orders. If a protest is filed the Department will attempt to settle the protest but will schedule a contested case hearing if necessary.

6. Final Order Issued

If no protests are filed, the Department can issue a Final Order within 60 days of the close of the period for receiving protest. If the application is approved, a permit is issued. The permit specifies the details of the authorized use and any terms, limitations or conditions that the Department deems appropriate.
