Dear Mr. Getner:

We have received your application for a permit to appropriate 1/80th of one cubic foot per second of water from an unnamed stream for domestic use of one family and ½ acre of lawn and garden along with a map, legal description, and the examination fee of \$20.00 for which our receipt No. 1469 is enclosed. This application has been filed and assigned No. 57148.

In order to file this application, you must authorize cancellation of permit No. 37924 which was for the same use. If you have misplaced the forms sent to you for this purpose, I am enclosing another form which you should sign and date and return to this office.

The water policy statement of the Water Resources Board of Oregon dated March 10, 1975 classifies use of the water from Canal Creek and its tributaries for, among other uses, domestic and the irrigation of lawn or non-commercial garden not to exceed ½ acre in area. A commercial use for nursery stock would not be allowed.

Item No. 3 of your application lists the place of use as being in the W_2 of the SE4. The use would appear to be in Lot 7 which is the NE4 of the SW4.

Item No. 3 of your application shows the use to be irrigation of ½ acre lawn and garden. The use listed under item No. 5 is domestic. If the use is to be domestic and irrigation of ½ acre lawn and garden, you should submit a recording fee of \$10.00 for the irrigation add \$15.00 for the domestic use for a total of \$25.00. If the use is to be domestic including the irrigation of not to exceed ½ acre lawn and garden, then the total recording fee would be \$15.00. Item No. 5 of your application should show the type of use and the irrigation should be listed as non-commercial lawn and garden to be acceptable from this source.

Your application map should show the township, range, and section in which the use is to be located.

I am returning your application and map for correction and completion. The application is endorsed so that it along with the map and affidavit authorizing cancellation of permit 37924 must be received in this office on or before May 22, 1978 to retain the priority date.

Thank you for the return of your corrected application No. 57148 and map, and for submitting the recording fee of \$25.00.
