



B. MEASUREMENT DEVICES, RECORDING, AND REPORTING CONDITION #2E was clarified to require annual written reports and supporting electronic data be submitted *to the Watermaster*.

C. REQUIRED 25 PERCENT INSTREAM FLOW PROTECTION (RIFP) CONDITION #1B was amended to read “The RIFP requirement *shall* be met through Transfer CW-92...” and “This water transferred instream *shall* be used to satisfy the initial requirements...”

### CONCLUSIONS OF LAW


1. The conclusions of law in the Proposed Final Order issued February 19, 2019 are incorporated herein with the above modifications.
2. The proposed use, as conditioned, would not impair or be detrimental to the public interest.

NOTE: When issuing permits, ORS 537.170(6) authorizes the Department to include provisions or restrictions concerning the use, control and management of the water to be appropriated for the project.

### ORDER

Application R-88231 is approved and Permit R-15387 is issued.
