Dear Sir:

Enclosed is form for making final proof
under Permit No. 13262 in the name of J. H. Pomeroy.

I made inspection of the work performed
under this permit during the 28th day of Sept., 1939
and found that the work had been completed and appar-
ently water could have been applied on lands as I have
indicated on the proof form.

Before making recommendation for the issuance
of a water right certificate, I believe that Mr.
Pomeroy should advise us on several points:

1. Will diversion points be changed each year or will they be practically the same as used during 1939?
2. We find in the Illinois River Decree, under proof 128, adjudicated water rights on some of the lands as listed in this permit and under proof 129 there are water rights and supplemental rights on some of the same lands. We believe that this permit should be indicated as a supplemental supply.
3. At the time of making inspection, clearing and leveling was being performed in the $SE\frac{1}{4}SE\frac{1}{4}$ of sec. 5. We determined there was 3 acres completed but Mr. Branham, who was in charge, advised us the intention was to develop all of that area. The question is whether applicant wishes an extension of time or whether he accepts the 3 acres, as we found.
4. Advise as to H.P. rating of motor and capacity of pump

Mr. Branham was present at the time of inspection. He requested that we present the matters to Mr. J. H. Pomeroy whose address is 333 Montgomery St., San Francisco, California.
