The amount of water requested is based on an estimate provided by the tree supplier calculated from data gathered from other growers and average rainfall in Yamhill, OR. To conserve water and prevent waste we will 1) cover the irrigated area around the trees with weed cloth to minimize evaporation; 2) during the first three years when the trees have a smaller root system, use stream deflectors to limit the irrigated area to a small radius around each tree; and 3) install a weather station with soil moisture monitor to limit watering to only what the plants need. We will install a gauge per OWRD specifications to measure the amount of water pumped from the reservoir. The surface waters we're requesting to use will be from a reservoir on our property that will be filled by natural water run-off. Therefore there should not be any risk of damage to or interference with any public water source.

SECTION 10: REMARKS

The area we intend to irrigate is covered under an existing water right per permit #G-13346. Our irrigation contractor recommended that we modify the plan submitted in the permit application G-13346 to build a reservoir as a "bulge in the system" (rather than using storage tanks) during the irrigation season as well as collect natural surface water run-off and water collected from building roof drains to conserve use of water drawn from our well. Our application for a permit to Store Water in a Reservoir (Alternate Review) # R-88697 to build the reservoir that is the "source" in this application was approved on June 10, 2019 and the Permit # is R-15389.

The reservoir will have a dam height of 9 feet and storage capacity of 8.96 acre feet. A spillway will be constructed on the western end of the dam that will send any live flow outside of the storage season into an existing drainage swale that feeds into an unnamed tributary of Rowland Creek.

Please note that the sole source of water we're applying for permission to use is the reservoir, which will be filled from runoff and used as a bulge in the system as needed, is the only source of water and no water will be diverted from any streams, rivers or lakes. The reference to Rowland Creek as "Tributary to" in section 2 only applies to any overflow from the reservoir.



GOODRICH ORCHARD TRACTS SUBDIVISION WAS APPROVED AND RECORDED ON MAY 19, 1909, AND CERTIFIED BY HENRY HERRING THEN COUNTY ENGINEER. PRIOR TO THAT HERRING DRAFTED A PLAT DATED APRIL 10, 1909 TITLED GOODRICH SUBDIVISIONS (NOW NOTED AS UNRECORDED PLAT #4 YAMHILL COUNTY SURVEYOR RECORDS). IN THE DRAWER WITH THE GOODRICH SUBDIVISIONS PLAT WAS A HERRING WORKSHEET FOR THAT PLAT AND POSSIBLY FOR THE EVENTUAL GOODRICH ORCHARD TRACTS PLAT. HERRING IN HIS FIELD NOTES DATED MARCH 29, 1909, CONDUCTED A SURVEY FOR M.M. GOODRICH, WHICH WAS THE PERIMETER BOUNDARY SURVEY FOR THE SUBSEQUENT PLATS. IN MY SURVEY RESEARCH FOR THIS WORK I NOTICED THAT IN CSP-9103 NORRIS JONES SET AN IRON ROD 25' FROM HIS CENTERLINE OF ADCOCK ROAD, THE EAST MARGIN OF WHICH IS 15' FROM CENTERLINE, AND HE NOTED IT AS FALLING IN THE SHOULDER OF THE ROAD. JONES BASED HIS CENTERLINE BETWEEN THE SW CORNER OF THE HENRY COOPER DLC #49 (#4) AND THE NE CORNER OF THE T.C. DAVIS DLC #38 (#2). I THOUGHT IT ODD THAT A 25' OFFSET TO THE CENTER OF THE ROAD WOULD FALL ON THE SHOULDER OF THE ROAD. THEN IN LOOKING AT CS-11822, BY JOHN NEWBERG, THAT THERE WAS ABOUT 15.3' OF PRORATION IN THE SOUTH LINE OF LOTS 28 & 29, WHICH ALSO STRUCK ME AS UNUSUAL FOR A HERRING SURVEY, WHO TYPICALLY MEASURED MORE ACCURATELY THAN THAT INDICATED. I STARTED THROUGH THE FIELD NOTES AND THE PLATS DONE BY HERRING AND CAME TO THE CONCLUSION THAT THE CENTER OF ADCOCK ROAD AS PLATTED IN GOODRICH ORCHARD TRACTS WAS NOT CENTERED BY A LINE BETWEEN CLAIM CORNERS, BUT AN OFFSET FROM THOSE CORNERS OF 15' ON EACH END, BUT IN OPPOSITE DIRECTIONS. FOR THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF LOT 28 1 HAVE HELD THE NORTH LINE OF THE A. JOB DLC #51 EXTENDED WESTERLY 15.00'. FOR THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF LOT 4 I HELD A POINT 15.00 FEET EASTERLY ON THE NORTH LINE OF THE JOHN GALBRAITH DLC #52 FROM THE NORTHERLY NW CORNER OF THAT CLAIM (#4). WHEN I DO THIS MY RECORD DIMNESIONS ALONG THE NORTH AND SOUTH LINES OF THE PLAT CHECK CLOSELY TO THE DIMENSIONS OF THE HERRING FIELD NOTES AND THE PLAT OF SOODRICH ORCHARD TRACTS AND THE GOODRICH SUBDIVISIONS PLAT WITH THE EXCEPTION OF LOT 1 THAT IS SHOWN ON GARDONAS BEING 819' AND ON G.S. AS BEING 825'. I HAVE HELD THE DIMENSION OF 819' FOR THE NORTHERLY WIDTH OF LOT 1. I MEASURED ADCOCK ROAD CENTERLINE FROM ITS SOUTHERLY END TO A POINT NORTH OF THE STO.
