Abstract of Permit

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **G-7484** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **Raymond L. and Loretta R. Frost** of **4001 Deer Creek Road, Selma, Oregon,** for use of the waters of **Sump 1**

for the PURPOSE of **irrigation**

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **August 18, 1976**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **0.25 cubic foot per second**

measured at the point of diversion from the **sump**, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: **1,760 feet North and 1,170 feet East** from the Southwest Corner of Section 9, being within the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 9, Township 38 South, Range 7 West, WM, in the County of Josephine.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall be further limited to appropriation of water only to the extent that it does not impair or substantially interfere with existing surface water rights of others, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **November 30, 1983**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 **84**.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 **85**.

confirms the right to use the waters of SUMP 1 in the DEER CREEK BASIN for the purpose of IRRIGATION^{ng}

The right has been perfected under Permit G-9921. The date of priority is AUGUST 18, 1976. The right is limited to not more than 0.25 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SW 1/4 SECTION 9, ~~TOWNSHIP 38 SOUTH, RANGE 7 WEST, W. M.~~ ^{delete 5P}

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4 4.0 ACRES
