In order for your application to be processed by the Water Resources Department (WRD), this Land Use Information Form must be completed by a local government planning official in the jurisdiction(s) where your water right will be used and developed. The planning official may choose to complete the form while you wait, or return the receipt stub to you. Applications received by WRD without the Land Use Form or the receipt stub will be returned to you. Please be aware that your application will not be approved without land use approval.

## This form is NOT required if:

- 1) Water is to be diverted, conveyed, and/or used only on federal lands; OR
- 2) The application is for a water right transfer, allocation of conserved water, exchange, permit amendment, or ground water registration modification, and all of the following apply:
  - a) The existing and proposed water use is located entirely within lands zoned for exclusive farm-use or within an irrigation district;
  - b) The application involves a change in place of use only;
  - c) The change does not involve the placement or modification of structures, including but not limited to water diversion, impoundment, distribution facilities, water wells and well houses; and
  - d) The application involves irrigation water uses only.

## NOTE TO LOCAL GOVERNMENTS

The person presenting the attached Land Use Information Form is applying for or modifying a water right. The Water Resources Department (WRD) requires its applicants to obtain land-use information to be sure the water rights do not result in land uses that are incompatible with your comprehensive plan. Please complete the form or detach the receipt stub and return it to the applicant for inclusion in their water right application. You will receive notice once the applicant formally submits his or her request to the WRD. The notice will give more information about WRD's water rights process and provide additional comment opportunities. You will have 30 days from the date of the notice to complete the land-use form and return it to the WRD. If no land-use information is received from you within that 30-day period, the WRD may presume the land use associated with the proposed water right is compatible with your comprehensive plan. 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

## STATUTORY WARRANTY DEED

Michael D. Simmons and Julie A. Simmons, Grantor, conveys and warrants to Tiffani A. Kealiher and Jeremiah L. Kealiher, as tenants by the entirety, Grantee, the following described real property, free and clear of encumbrances except as specifically set forth below, situated in the County of Polk, State of Oregon:

A part of the Donation Land Claim of Israel Hedges and wife, Not No. 1650, Claim No. 46, in Township 8 South, Range 4 West of the Willamette Meridian in Polk County, Oregon, beginning at a point 82 links East of the Northwest corner of the Donation Land Claim of B. F. Burch and wife, No. 53; and running thence East 14.68 chains; thence North 21° East 5.45 chains; thence North 81° 30' West 15 chains; thence West 15.77 chains; thence South 13° West 7.52 chains; thence East 15.69 chains to the place of beginning.

Beginning at the intersection of the Westerly right-of-way line of Market Road No. 9 and the Northerly boundary line of the Benjamin F.
