Dear Sir and Madam:

This will acknowledge receipt of your notices of completion of construction and complete application of water for your reservoir permit number R-3263.

You did not indicate on the forms whether you had made complete application of water under the terms of your permit number 28814 which is for the appropriation of 1.85 cubic feet per second from Williams Creek and King's Reservoir for the supplemental irrigation of 148.0 acres.

Under the terms of permit number 28814, the date for completion of construction and complete application of water is October 1, 1967.

If you have all of the equipment and/or facilities necessary to irrigate the intended acreage, then the enclosed Form B should be completed and returned to this office. If you have covered all of the intended acreage with at least one beneficial irrigation, then the enclosed Form C should be completed and returned to this office.

Dear Sir and Madam:

This will acknowledge receipt of an application for extension of the time limits to complete construction of the reservoir under permit No. R-3363 and the fee of \$2 for which our receipt No. 1448 is enclosed.

The time limits under any permit are based on the date of issuance of the permit and the extensions of time can be granted only on the total progress since the permit was issued. Although you are at a disadvantage on getting a piece of property at a rather late date, there are not new time limits set up for a new property owner. The information submitted and the conflict between that and what Mr. Katzenbach previously submitted, there is some question whether or not there has been reasonable progress since the permit was issued July 8, 1963. However, you will be given the benefit of the doubt, and we will extend the time limit under both permits until October 1, 1967 to allow you one more year to complete the project to the desired extent.
