Dear Bob:

We have received the affidavit of abandonment regarding parts of the rights described by certificates No. 2745 and 21695 regarding lands presently owned by Raymond L. and Loretta R. Frost.

In comparing the affidavit with the applicants map, it appears they intend to abandon all of the two particular rights on lands described by their application. It further appears they intend to keep that part of the two rights which lies south of the county road, west of Crooks Creek, and above the land described by their application. If this is the case, their application map indicates a total of 9.3 acres to remain.

If 5.3 acres of certificate No. 2745 is to be kept, then 1.7 acres is to be abandoned. Also, if 5.3 acres is to be kept, the remainder of the land to be abandoned must be then described under certificate No. 21695 which would leave 2.2 acres in the SW2 NW2 and 1.8 acres in the NW2 SW2, the rest of the right is then to be abandoned.

If you agree, I have prepared a new affidavit to be in agreement with lands as shown by the applicants map. The new affidavit should be signed by the Frosts and returned to this office. Permits then can be issued in approval of their new applications.

There are also two new certificates to be issued regarding the remainder of each right. Therefore, an additional \$4.00 is required in certificate recording fees. This should be submitted along with the completed affidavit.

## Dear Bob:

We have received maps, fees of \$80.00, legal land descriptions and 4 applications submitted by Raymond L. and Loretta R. Frost. For reference, these applications are Nos. G-7482, G-7483, G-7484 and G-7485.

Application No. G-7482 is for a permit to use 350 gallons per minute of water from sump No. 2 for irrigation of approximately 25 acres. Application No. G-7483 is for a permit to use 170 GPM of water from sump No. 3 for irrigation of 10 acres. Application No. G-7484 is for a permit to use 250 GPM of water from sump No. 1 for irrigation of from 10 to 25 acres and application No. G-7485 is for a permit to use 200 GPM of water from sump No. 4 for irrigation of 30 acres.

The maps that accompanied these applications do not appear to be prepared to a uniform scale and were not prepared with reference to the government survey showing the Section lines and quarter-quarter sections lines in the vicinity, therefore it is somewhat difficult to locate the intended project.

From the legal land description of the property along with records of this office, I have attempted to prepare a composite map showing the land intended to be irrigated from each sump. The information I have, however, is not adequate. Therefore, I would appreciate your assistance in completing these applications.

In addition to the mapping errors, the applications themselves must describe specific projects and be in agreement with the maps. I believeetemapewould be sufficient to illustrate each of the 4 projects.

In addition to the examination fee for each application, the permit recording fees must also be submitted. This depends, of course, upon the acreage to be irrigated under each application.

There are also existing water rights on the property from Crooks Creek described by certificates No. 2745 and 21695. Certificate No. 2745 is evidence of the right to irrigate 7 acres from Crooks Creek and certificate No. 21695 is evidence of the right to irrigate 60 acres from Crooks Creek. I am enclosing copies of the maps regarding these two certificates.

If the rights to use of water from Crooks Creek are still valid, it would appear they cover all of the land between the County Road on the North and Crooks Creek on the South. Therefore, the applications for permits to use water from sumps No. 1, 2, and 3 should be requesting supplemental irrigation.

I am sending you the # applications along with the maps for correction and completion of the applications and providing a proper map and the additional fees. Your assistance in contacting the applicant for these corrections is appreciated.

Applications No. G-7482, G-7483, G-7484 and G-7485 are endorsed so that in order to retain their dates of priority, they must be received in this office on or before March 21, 1977.
