According to the terms of your Permit G-9923 complete application of water was to have been made by October 1, 1985. This permit is for the appropriation of 0.18 cubic foot per second of water from Sump 5 for the purpose of irrigation.

Complete application of water means the application of water to a beneficial use under the permit to the full extent intended. In the case of irrigation, it means beneficial irrigation of all the lands the permittee intends to cover under the terms of the permit. If the water has been used, you should promptly submit notice describing the extent of completion as set forth in the letter accompanying your permit and also in our postal card of October 11, 1985.

ORS 537.260 provides that: "Whenever the time within which any appropriation under a permit should have been perfected has expired and the owner of the permit fails or refuses within three months thereafter to submit to the Water Resources Director proof of completion of the appropriation as required by ORS 537.230 and 537.250, the Water Resources Director may, after 60 days notice by registered mail, order the cancellation of the permit.."

In accordance with the provisions of ORS 537.260, you are hereby notified that unless proof of beneficial use is received within 60 days from the date of this letter, the permit(s) may be canceled without further notice.

If, for any reason, you are no longer interested in the project described by the permit, we would appreciate it if you would so advise. If the property involved has changed hands and any part of the project has been completed, you should immediately assign the permit to the new owner and advise us of his name and address. An assignment form will be furnished upon request.

I epologize for the long delay in the processing of your Applications 1-7482, G-7483, G-7484, G-7485 and G-7924 which were originally filed in August of 1976 and March of 1977. As mentioned in our recent telephone discussion, there were matters that needed to be resolved in regard to clearing our records of the existing rights involved. The sonlications, at that time, were placed with several other applications that needed further attention. We are now attempting to complete the processing of these applications.

Your Applications C-7482, C-7483, C-7484 and G-7485 were returned to you in January of 1977 for correction and completion. These applications were again received in March of 1977 with four superading applications and an additional application which was filed and numbered C-7974. The sepis print of a tax assessor's map showing the location of the supers and lands to be irrigated was also received. These five applications presently describe projects as follows:

Application U-7482 describes the intended use of 0.6 cubic fort per second from 5.7% Summ 2 for indigation of 23.0 ecres.

Application G-748% describes the intended use of 0.4 of from N.W. Sumo & for the irrigation of 10.0 series.

Application (4-7484 describes the intended use of 0.5 ets frame rooks Treek Sump I for the intended of 20.0 peres.

Application G-7483 describes the intended use of 0.5 ets frage. Dryden Line Sump a for the irrigation of 35.0 acres.

Appliestion G-7924 describes the intended use of D.28 ofs from Tranks Creek Sump 5 for the irrigation of 14,6 screek Raymond L. and Loretta R. Frest November 8, 1982 page two

The matters regarding the existing rights have been taken care of by Orders entered October 19, 1982. These Orders canceled the parts of the existing rights involved which were described by Cartificates 2745 and 21625. Copies of these Orders are enclosed.

Your five applications are in satisfactory form and will be placed with the next group to be considered for approval.

Dear Bob:

We have received the affidavit of abandonment regarding parts of the rights described by certificates No. 2745 and 21695 regarding lands presently owned by Raymond L. and Loretta R. Frost.

In comparing the affidavit with the applicants map, it appears they intend to abandon all of the two particular rights on lands described by their application. It further appears they intend to keep that part of the two rights which lies south of the county road, west of Crooks Creek, and above the land described by their application. If this is the case, their application map indicates a total of 9.3 acres to remain.

If 5.3 acres of certificate No. 2745 is to be kept, then 1.7 acres is to be abandoned. Also, if 5.3 acres is to be kept, the remainder of the land to be abandoned must be then described under certificate No. 21695 which would leave 2.2 acres in the SWk NWk and 1.8 acres in the NWk SWk, the rest of the right is then to be abandoned.

If you agree, I have prepared a new affidavit to be in agreement with lands as shown by the applicants map. The new affidavit should be signed by the Frosts and returned to this office. Permits then can be issued in approval of their new applications.

There are also two new certificates to be issued regarding the remainder of each right. Therefore, an additional \$4.00 is required in certificate recording fees. This should be submitted along with the completed affidavit.
