This letter is to inform you that our water board has decided to give Umpqua Basin Water until April 30, 1981 to pay their 1980 and 1981 Annual Base Fees, totalling \$2000. If this fee is not paid by that date it is this boards wishes to have the county institute the necessary action to have Umpqua Basin Water removed from water right permit #43056 issued by the State of Oregon Water Resources Department for 500 acre feet of water being stored behind Berry Creek Dam in the Ben Irving Reservoir.

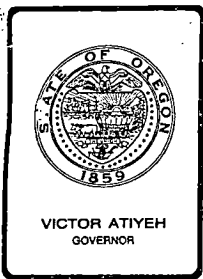

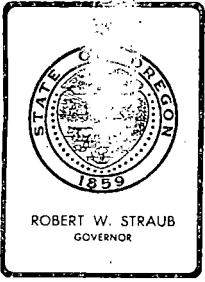

The plans and specifications for the Berry Creek Dam have been reviewed and approved, and permits issued. Copies of the approved plans and specifications have been forwarded to the applicant. Because this structure exceeds the size limits for exempt structures, construction must be supervised by an engineer licensed to practice in Oregon, or by a qualified representative of the federal government. 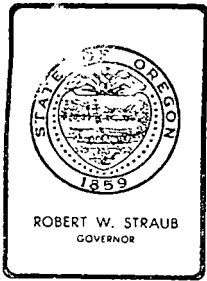
Please advise this office when construction starts so that we may schedule periodic field inspections.

The plans and specifications for the Berry Creek Dam, including Addendums No. 1, 2, and 3 to the contract documents, have been reviewed and approved.

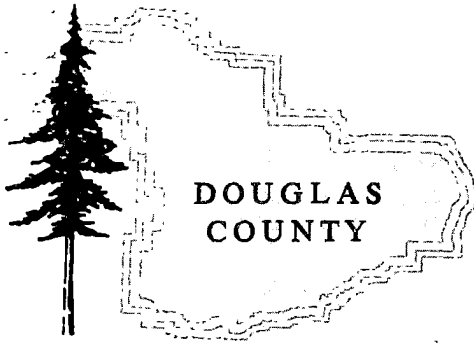
The applications for water right are being processed by our permits division. You will be advised when the permits have been issued. Approved copies of the plans and specifications will be forwarded to you at that time.

Gentlemen:

By this letter, Douglas County Water Resources Survey requests that the priority date for our surface water appropriation of 1,500 a.f. from the unnamed reservoir on Berry Creek, a tributary of Olalla Creek, be the same date as the Oregon Fish and Wildlife Department's appropriation of 750 a.f. from the same source.

This is being requested, so that in the event there are years when there is not enough stored water to fully meet the rights of both users, neither user could claim a prior right. Hence, both users would be pro-rated water based on their appropriation.

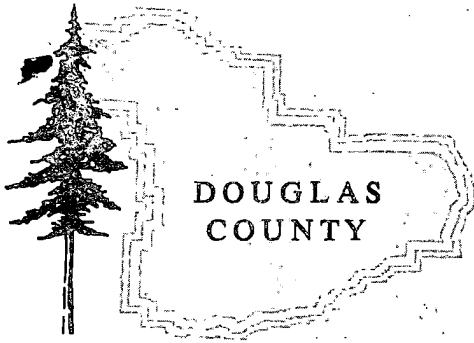


