Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 750 a.f. of stored water only measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from a reservoir to be constructed under application No. R 56608, permit No. R - 7256

The use to which this water is to be applied is streamflow augmentation for fish and wildlife.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.


The priority date of this permit is May 12, 1978

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 1, 1979 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19.80

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19.81

Dear John:

The Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife requests the 750 acre feet of stream enhancement water stored in Ben Irving Reservoir be released between now and October 1, 1980. Since Douglas County will be releasing more water than normal during October this year, and the reservoir has to be drained, the stream enhancement water should be released earlier than we would normally request.

Information:

Spoke with Mr. Dave Anderson of O.D.F.W. Mr. Anderson told me that the O.D.F.W. had requested water from Ben Irving Reservoir for "stream enhancement" (see copy of request attached). He told me that they have, every year, asked for water to be released. This water was to augment stream flow for the ~~first~~ time after the irrigation season and lasting until the first rains. Per the attached letter, they requested an early release in 1980 since the reservoir was due to be drained. Mr. Anderson told me that the contact person should be Mr. Greg Robart at revised address and phone # on front of this permit.

I also spoke with Mr. Don Henry of Douglas County Water Resources. He told me that the information provided by Mr. Anderson of O.D.F.W. was basically correct. He had no way of showing me the exact amount of water released, each year, for O.D.F.W. His estimate was that within the period 1978 to 1981 they had requested and received 250 A.F. per year.
