

Abstract of Permit

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 65305 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to James and Jeanne Wallace of 22761 Umpqua Highway, Glide, Oregon 97443, phone 496-0104, for the use of the waters of North Umpqua River, tributary Umpqua River,

for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from July 15, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 490 NORTH 2900 W 1/4 960 feet South and 300 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 11, being within the (SW 1/4 NE 1/4) of Section 11, Township 26 South, Range 3 West, WM, in the County of Douglas, BEING WITHIN LOT #7
