Proof of Appropriation of Water

FRANK GIBBONS

of Box 173, N. Myrtle Route, Myrtle Creek, State of Oregon,  
has applied beneficially the waters of  
North Fork of Myrtle Creek

a tributary of South Umpqua River for the purpose of  
irrigation of 4.0 acres

under Permit No. 30702 of the State Engineer, and that the use of said waters has been  
completed under the terms of said permit; that the priority of the  
right dates from August 9, 1965

that the amount of water for the purposes aforesaid, has been actually beneficially used in the  
amount of  
0.05 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.  
The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within Jones DLC 48, Section  
23, T. 29 S., R. 5 W., W. M. Diversion point located 700 feet North and 310 feet  
East from SW Corner of DLC 48.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other  
right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ~~one-eighth~~ one-eighth of one cubic foot per second  
per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited  
to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated  
during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.  
A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is  
as follows:

4.0 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$   
as projected within Jones DLC 48  
Section 14  
T. 29 S., R. 5 W., W. M.
