A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Application History

Permit G-15631 was issued by the Department on May 20, 2004. The permit complete application of water to beneficial use by October 1, 2008. On August 7, 2019, Hugh Eisele submitted an Application for Extension of Time for Permit G-15631. In accordance with OAR 690-315-0050(2), on September 17, 2019, the Department issued a Proposed Final Order proposing to extend the time to fully apply water to beneficial use to October 1, 2020. The protest period closed November 1, 2019, in accordance with OAR 690-315-0060(1). No protest was filed.

FINDINGS OF FACT

The Department adopts and incorporates by reference the findings of fact in the Proposed Final Order dated September 17, 2019.

The extension of time for Application G-15823, Permit G-15631, therefore, is approved. The deadline for applying water to full beneficial use within the terms and conditions of the permit is extended from October 1, 2008, to October 1, 2020.
