Certificate of Water Right issued to D. I. Simmons and recorded at page 8528, Volume 8, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms a right under Permit number 8505, with a date of priority of May 15, 1928, for the use of 0.1 c.f.s. of the waters of "Tommy East" Creek (Rogue River) for domestic use, including irrigation of garden and lawn.

Contacted Mr. Ross Sutherland, who is the present
owner. Mr. Simmons is deceased.

Mr. Sutherland said that all his lawn, garden and orchard land was washed away in the 1964 flood. He lost approx. A. Acres of the 10 Acres he owned leaving 6 Acres now.

He said, the only water use now is domestic water for I cabin for 6 wks. out of the year. He lives in Hawaii and vacations on the Rogue.

Mr. Sutherland said that the only nearby Gov. Cor. (S.W. cor. Sec. 20) was destroyed by the 1964 flood. He also stated that his property is wholly within Sec. 20. If there was a corner in Sec. 29 it washed away in the flood.

He said his cabin is presently located approx. 300' downstream from Tom East Creek &

Because of winter flooding he must take up the plastic water pipe each fall, and replace it next year, not always in the same place.
