Summary

Order approving the renewal of Application G-12961 and issuance of Permit G-18305.

Authority

The application was processed in accordance with Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) 690-502-0200. These administrative rules provide the authority to extend a water use permit, for a period not to exceed five years, provided that the groundwater resource can probably support the extended use.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. On June 4, 1992, Earl J Van Volkinburg submitted an application to the Department for a water use permit. The proposed use is located in the South Salem Hills Groundwater Limited Area.
- 2. The Department issued a water use permit on October 24, 1994. This permit expired in October 1999. The permit was renewed in April 2002, November 2004, and August 2015.
- 3. On September 12, 2019, the Department received a request for partial assignment from Earl J Van Volkinburg to Kay and Robert Freund. The attached permit reflects this assignment request.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Department finds that the groundwater resource can probably support the extended use.

NOTE: When issuing permits, ORS 537.628(1) authorizes the Department to include limitations and conditions which have been determined necessary to protect the public welfare, safety and health.

ORDER

Application G-12961 has been renewed and Permit G-18305 is issued. The permit shall expire on October 1, 2020.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is a Final Order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 536.075 and ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to OAR 137-004-0080 you may petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.
