Proof of Appropriation of Water

W. C. WYCOFF

of Rt. 2, Box 1120, Bandon, State of Oregon 97411,
has applied beneficially the waters of
a spring area

a tributary of Coquille River for the purpose of
domestic use for one family including the irrigation of lawn and garden not to
exceed one-half acre in area
under Permit No. 42684 and that the use of said waters has been completed under the
terms of said permit; that the priority of the right dates from
December 20, 1977
that the amount of water for the purposes aforesaid, has been actually beneficially used in the
amount of
0.01 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.
The point of diversion is located in the Lot 4 (NW 1/4 SW 1/4), Section 16, T28S,
R14W, WM; 2550 feet North and 440 feet East from the SW Corner of Section 16.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other
right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _____ of one cubic foot per second
per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is
as follows:

Lot 3 (SW 1/4 NW 1/4)
Section 16
Township 28 South, Range 14 West, WM
