Your Application 68382 describing the proposed use of 0.0125 cubic foot of water per second per acre for lawn and garden irrigation on 0.8 acre, together with the three prints of a map and deed copy, have been reviewed.

It will be necessary for you to advise us of how you intend to utilize water under the terms of a permit approving your new Application 68382 with relationship to the use of water allowed under your earlier Permit 44499 which provided for the use of 0.01 cfs from a mountain spring for domestic use for the one family including the irrigation of a lawn and non-commercial garden not exceeding one-half acre in area. If you intend to retain the right to the use of water from the mountain spring as the primary source for the irrigation of part of the acreage and utilize water from the river to make up for any deficiency in supply, it will be necessary for you to smend Item 5 to list the use as irrigation and supplemental irrigation and further complete Item 3 by stating the acreage to receive the supplemental supply of water and the acreage to receive the primary supply of water from the river. Your supporting map will also need to be further completed to illustrate in different manners the acreage to receive the supplemental supply and acreage to receive the primary supply.

So that you may review your application, I am returning it to you along with the map for completion. The application is endorsed so that in order to retain its priority date it must be received in this office on or before September 3, 1985.
