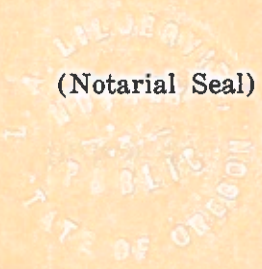

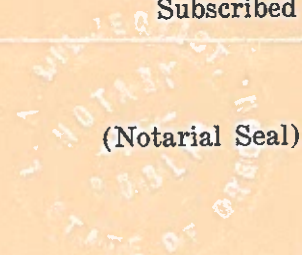


AFFIDAVIT OF WITNESSES
