#### C. Conservation

Please describe why the amount of water requested is needed and measures you propose to: prevent waste; measure the amount of water diverted; prevent damage to aquatic life and riparian habitat; prevent the discharge of contaminated water to a surface stream; prevent adverse impact to public uses of affected surface waters.

The requested commercial rate and duty are based on design information for the operation/processing activities. Best management practices will be utilized to prevent waste. The nursery rate and duty are consistent with standard industry practices for other similar facilities in the area (1/40th cfs per acre and 5 AF/acre per year). Best management practices will also be utilized in the nursery operations. Flow meters will be installed at each well head. The place of use and points of appropriation are located in upland areas so no damage to aquatic life or riparian habitat is anticipated. During well installation and facilities construction best management practices will be utilized to prevent erosion and the discharge of contaminated water. There is no surface water bodies on or adjoining the property therefore with the utilization of best management practices no adverse impact to public uses or water bodies is anticipated.
