Proof of Appropriation of Water

GEORGE W. SMITH

of Box 206, Coos River Route, Coos Bay, State of Oregon, 97420, has applied beneficially the waters of an unnamed stream

a tributary of Smith Creek for the purpose of domestic use for three families including the irrigation of lawn and garden not to exceed 1/2 acre in area and stock under Permit No. 34831 and that the use of said waters has been completed under the terms of said permit; that the priority of the right dates from

December 23, 1969 that the amount of water for the purposes aforesaid, has been actually beneficially used in the amount of

0.02 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 c.f.s. for domestic use and 0.01 c.f.s. for stock

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 27, T. 25 S., R. 12 W., W. M., 1110 feet South and 2630 feet West from E 1/4 Corner, Section 27.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Domestic and Stock Lot 5 (SW 1/4 NW 1/4) Section 26 Domestic and Stock Lot 4 (SE 1/4 NE 1/4) Stock NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 27 T. 25 S., R. 12 W., W. M.
