that the amount of water for the purposes aforesaid, has been actually beneficially used in the amount of **0.19 cubic foot per second**

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the NEW SEW, Section 3, T. 33 S., R. 7 W., W. M. Diversion point located: 3480 feet South and 600 feet West from NE Corner, Section 3.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-seventieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
