

LEGAL DESCRIPTION
OF PROPERTY UPON WHICH WATER IS TO BE USED UNDER THIS APPLICATION:

Two adjoining parcels of land having a combined area of 5.58 acre in D.L.C. NO. 43 in Section 23, Township 40 South, Range 8 West of the Willamette Meridian, Josephine County, Oregon, more particularly described as follows:

TAX LOT 706, 5.00 acre:

Commencing at the Southwest Corner of said D.L.C. NO. 43; thence North $0^{\circ}39'$ East, 778.51 feet along the West line of said D.L.C. NO. 43 to the true point of beginning; thence South $69^{\circ}27'$ East, 693.35 feet to an iron rod on the Westerly right of way line of Bridgeview-Takilma Road; thence along said right of way line North $26^{\circ}11'$ East, 247.50 feet to an iron rod; thence North $63^{\circ}49'$ West, 840.74 feet to an iron rod on the West line of said D.L.C. NO. 43; thence South $0^{\circ}39'$ West, 349.72 feet along the West line of said D.L.C. NO. 43 to the true point of beginning.

TAX LOT 791, 0.58 acre:

Commencing at the Southwest corner of D.L.C. NO. 43 in Section 23, Township 40 South, Range 8 West, Willamette Meridian, Josephine County, Oregon; thence North along the West line of said D.L.C. NO. 43 1128.23 feet to an iron rod, which is the true point of beginning; thence South $63^{\circ}49'$ East, 840.74 feet to an iron rod on the Westerly right of way line of Bridgeview-Takilma Road; thence North $26^{\circ}11'$ East along said right of way line a distance of 30 feet to an iron rod; thence North $63^{\circ}49'$ West, 855.07 feet to an iron rod; thence South $0^{\circ}39'$ West, 33.24 feet along the west line of said D.L.C. NO. 43 to the true point of beginning.

These adjoining parcels are owned by the applicants, Thomas W. Nevling and Tracy C. Harris. The spring which is the source of the water the applicants wish to appropriate is within the boundaries of the above described tax lot 706. The pond from which water would be diverted for irrigation and domestic use occupies portions of both the above described tax lots. Both of the points from which water would be diverted (described in item# 2 of the Application for Permit to Appropriate Surface Water) lie within the bounds of the above described tax lot 706.
