A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Application History

Permit G-17304 was issued by the Department on October 23, 2014. The permit specified completion of construction and application of water was to be made within five years of the date of permit issuance, being October 23, 2019. On December 12, 2019, the permit holder submitted to the Department an Application for Extension of Time for Permit G-17304. In accordance with OAR 690-315-0050(2), on January 21, 2020, the Department issued a Proposed Final Order proposing to deny the time to complete and the time to fully apply water to beneficial use to October 1, 2029. The protest period closed March 6, 2020, in accordance with OAR 690-315-0060(1). No protest was filed.

FINDINGS OF FACT

The Department adopts and incorporates by reference the findings of fact in the Proposed Final Order dated January 21, 2020.

At time of issuance of the Proposed Final Order the Department concluded that, based on the factors demonstrated by the applicant, any comments received, and information within the file, the permit may not be extended.

CONCLUSION OF LAW

The applicant has not demonstrated good cause for the permit extension pursuant to ORS 537.630, 539.010(5) and OAR 690-315-0040(2).

ORDER

The extension of time for Application G-17748, Permit G-17304, therefore, denied.
