This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.005 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from a spring

trib South Umpqua River

The use to which this water is to be applied is supplemental domestic use for one family.

~~If for irrigation, This appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated.~~ 25 gallons per day

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is August 29, 1977

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 12, 1979 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1979

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1980

INFO: Mary Emmott, widow of Ronald B Emmott, indicated spring location and explained its use

SOURCE: unkn. spring

USE: supplemental domestic @ family
(primary is drilled well)

DIV PT: a small truck coming ~~from~~ stream bank ~6" above current stream level. Spring is on east side of the unnamed stream and is 10' downstream from a box culvert under HWY 99.

EQUIPMENT: No pump or pipe were ever used. Water was simply scooped out of a depression in stream bank, and hand-carried in a bowl.

REMARKS: This small spring serves as an emergency source of water. It ~~was~~ was used in 1977 and R. Emmott filed to protect it. R. Emmott died and Mary Emmott is 85 years old.

There is a possible connection between this spring and drilled well (primary source). The two are 20' apart.
