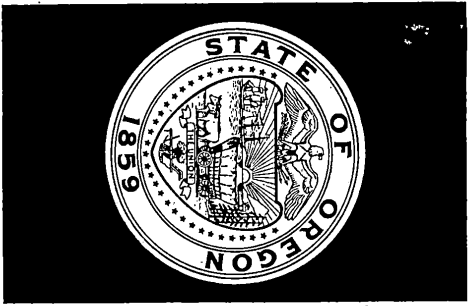

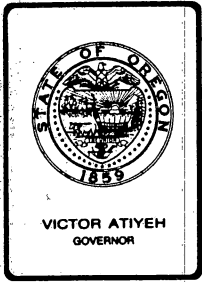

On July 5, 1984, a representative of this office made an inspection of land in connection with your Permit 42450. This permit was issued for "supplemental domestic" use from a spring.

According to the report by our examiner, the spring is an emergency backup to your domestic well. You explained that the water from the spring was hand-carried in a bowl to the house. Our examiner reports no development at the spring, and no evidence of a pump or piping to the house. If this information is correct, the permit is not valid and should be cancelled. The Director cannot issue a Certificate of Water Right for a use which has no measurable diversion of water.

Enclosed is a form for your use in authorizing the cancellation of this permit. The cancellation would clear it from our records and avoid the necessity for further notices or correspondence.

in consideration of Ten and no/100 - - - - - Dollars, and other consideration to them paid by RONALD B. EMMOTT and MARY A. EMMOTT,

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said RONALD B. EMMOTT and MARY A. EMMOTT, husband and wife

as tenants by the entirety, their heirs and assigns, all the following real property, with the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances, situated in the County of Douglas and State of Oregon, bounded and described as follows, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point on the North right of way line of U. S. 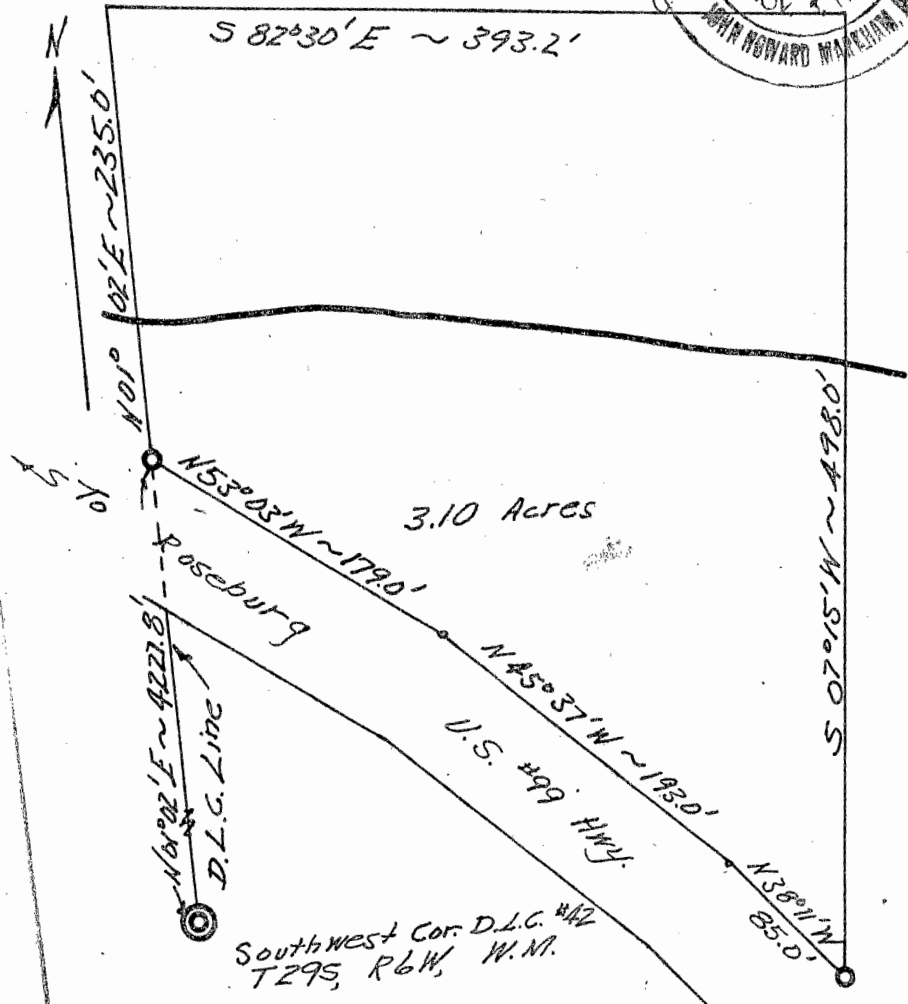
