

PATRICIA WALKER, Grantor, convey(s) and warrant(s) to MOUNTAIN VALLEY INVESTMENTS, LLC, an Oregon Limited Liability Company, Grantee, the following described real property free of liens and encumbrances, except as specifically set forth herein:


