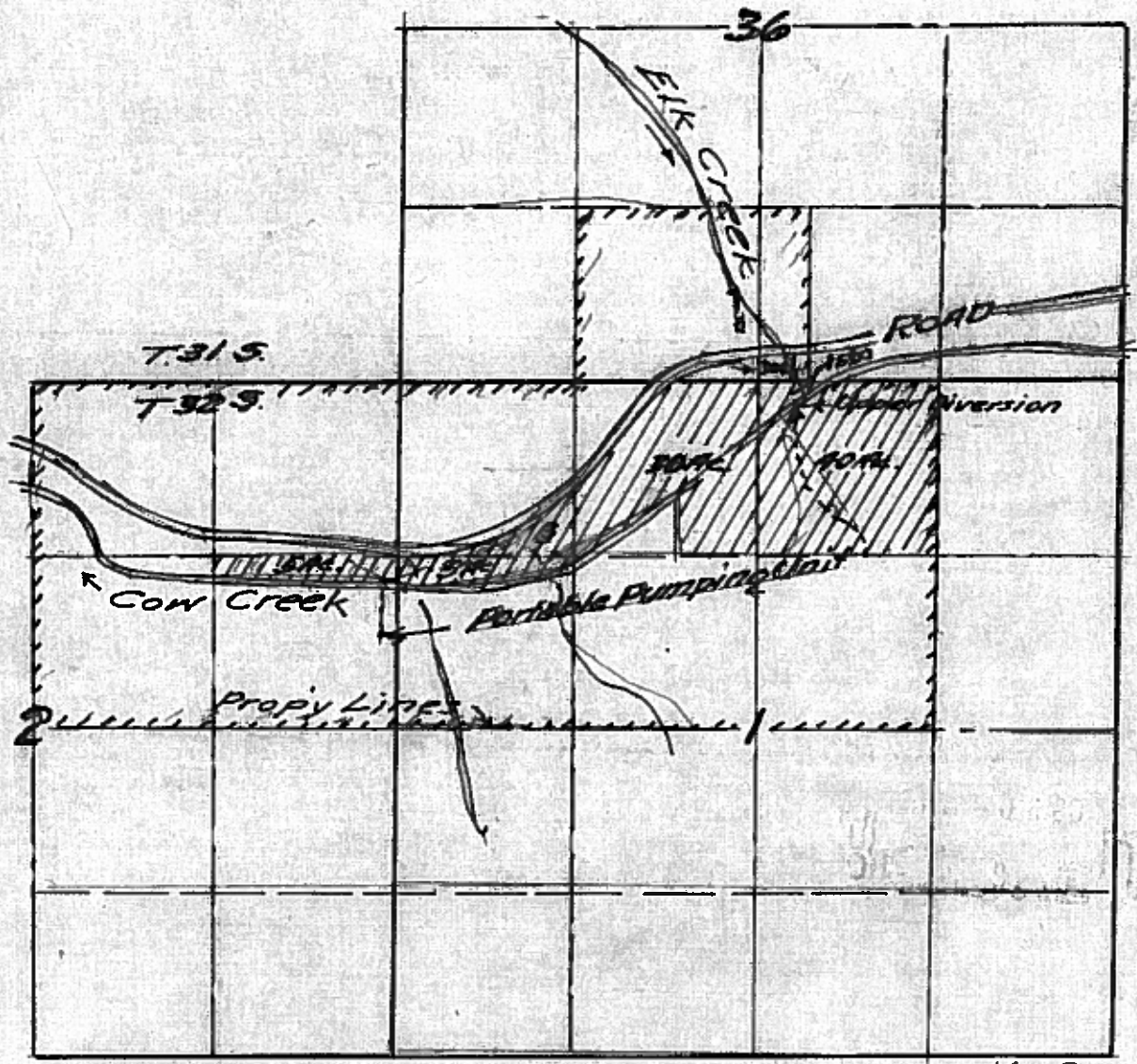

Dear Mr. Hauck:

In reply to your letter of April 30, a search of our records discloses two water rights of record in your name which are evidenced by the certificates recorded at pages 20607 and 20608, State Record of Water Rights Certificates.

The certificate recorded at page 20627 describes the appropriation of not to exceed 0.01 second foot of water from Elk Creek, with a date of priority of June 20, 1950, for domestic use of one family.

The certificate recorded at page 20608 describes the appropriation of not to exceed 0.79 second foot of water from Cow Creek, with a date of priority of June 20, 1950, for the irrigation of 55.3 acres of land.

Completed and perfected water rights as evidenced by the certificates are appurtenant to the lands upon which the rights were established and travel with the land through change of ownership unless reserved by deed. The law does not provide for making the change of ownership of such a right a matter of record in this office.

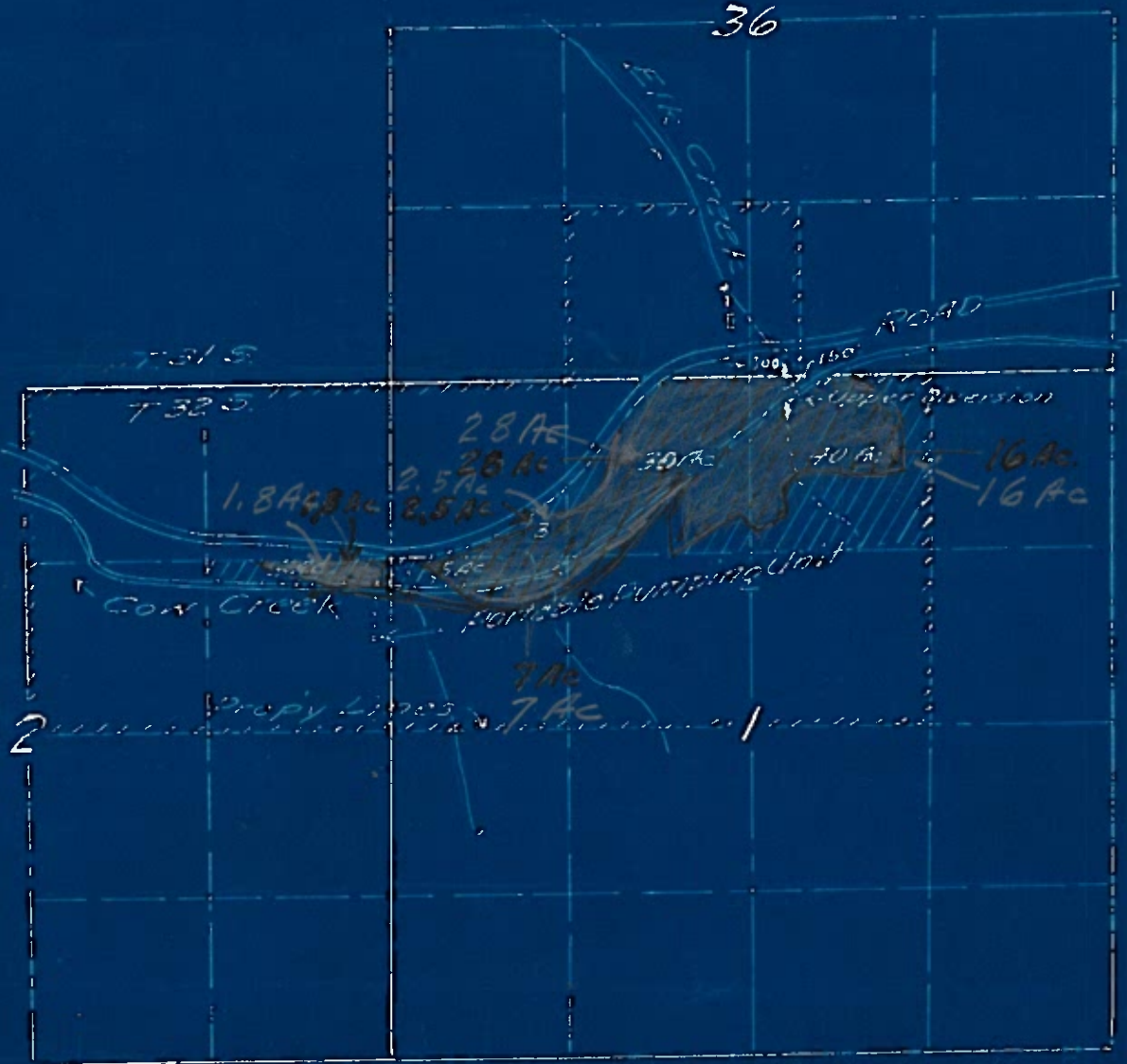

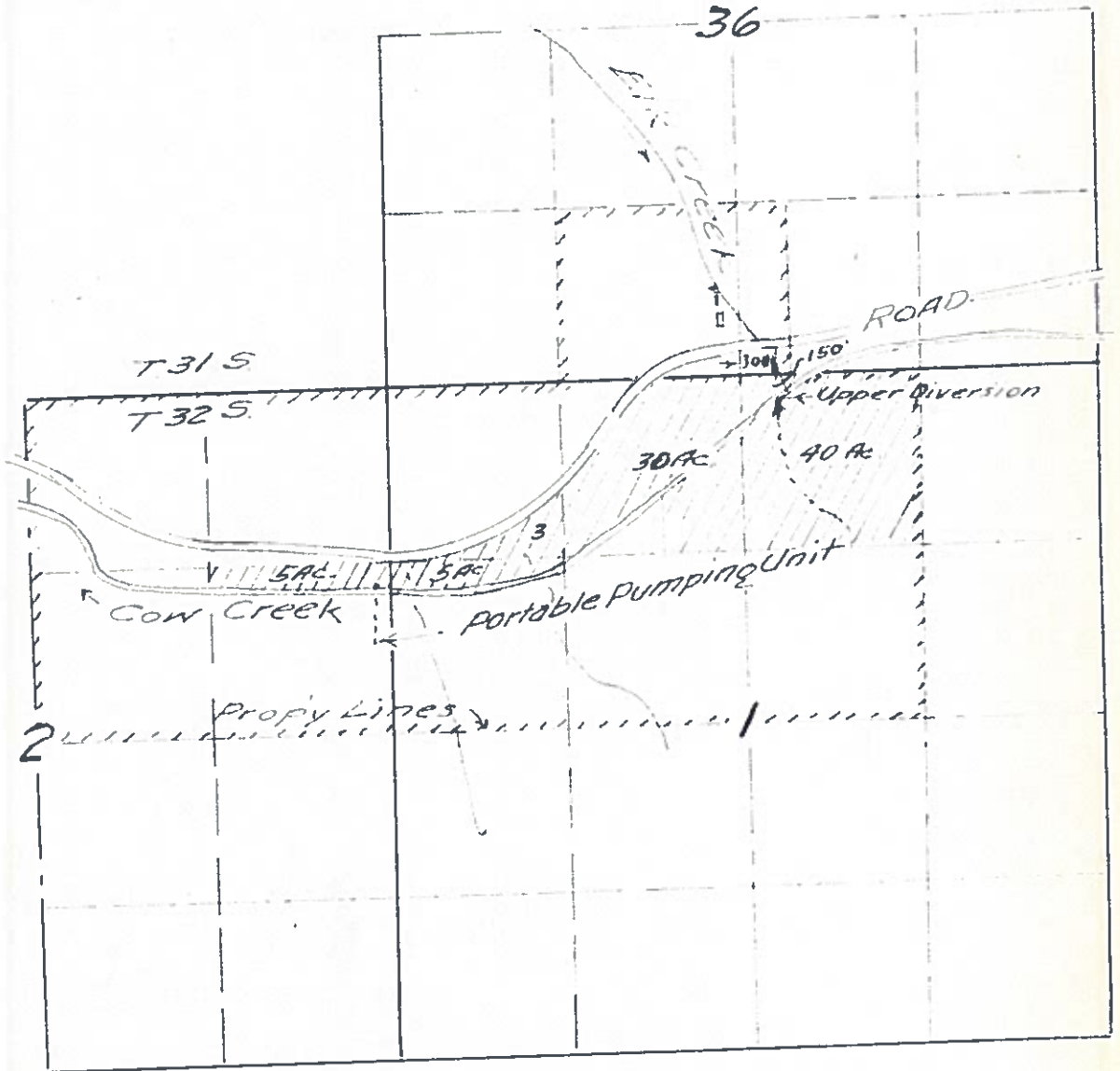
