This Weyerhaeuser farm uses seeds harvested from its on farm orchards to grow new trees for reforestation planting. In the period from Oct. 1 to May 31, these small trees need to be protected from below freezing temperatures with high pressure sprinklers. It is proposed by this application to add new temperature control (TC) of 4.3 cfs to 52.6 acres within the footprints of GR-170 and Cert. 24690 IS from Well 4, 5, or 6.

The PLSS grid used on the application map matches the grid on the final proof maps for Certificates 49070 and 49071. These certificates involve the same footprint as application G-18739 which is meant to work in conjunction with this application. As discussed with OWRD, groundwater section should use the following coordinate description for evaluating Well 4 on the department used grid: 715'S and 1820'E from NW corner of Section 9. When it is time to do the claim of beneficial use, OAR 690-14-0110 will be applied and Well 4 location will be claimed to match existing water rights of record. Wells 5 and 6 will also use the grid of the final proof maps for the purposes of this application.
